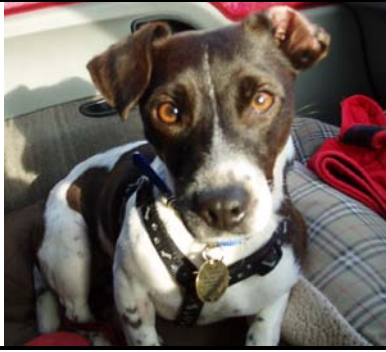
3. Alf
