1. Scally



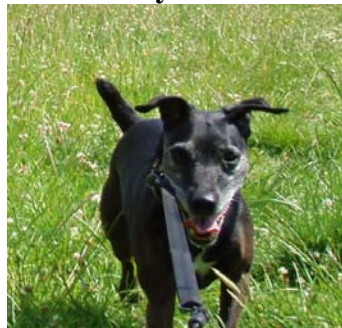
